## Current Available DAVA Services - 07490-038-170

- Nelson and Jeridith are still operating as a 24/7, 365 telephonic support for anyone needing help navigating a violent situation.
  - This includes initial reports, safety planning, information/resources, etc.
  - We are also happy to discuss hypothetical situations if a victim is not ready to come forward with a full allegation.
- We are able to meet victims in the emergency department for emergencies only.
- Restricted reporting options available.
- Please note that the off-base emergency shelters that typically work with Americans are all <u>currently at full capacity</u>.
- If a victim feels unsafe, the best course of action is to first call the police (911 on base, 999 off base) and then the DAVA.
- The victim can also appear in person to the emergency department or security forces.
  - Please note that if the victim provides a statement to security forces, then restricted reporting is no longer an option.
